Key Registration Notes:

- Registration fees apply only to author(s) who will physically attend the conference on the event day.
- If an abstract has multiple authors, all authors and co-authors attending in person must complete registration and pay the corresponding fee.
- If a paper has more than two authors, only one author may present it.
- Registration will open only after abstract acceptance results have been announced.
- On spot registration with limited facilities.

Special Note

- ❖ Abstracts must be 250–300 words in length and in a single paragraph.
- ❖ Only original and unpublished research work is eligible for submission.
- ❖ Abstracts based on research that has been published previously, either in full or in part, will not be considered for review.
- ❖ Conference registration will open only after the announcement of abstract acceptance results.
- ❖ Each research group may submit a maximum of two (2) abstracts. For multiple submissions:
 - Each abstract must have a different corresponding author.
 - Each submission must be made using a different corresponding author's email address.
 - The presenting author must also be different for each abstract.
- ❖ If an individual has two abstracts accepted and wishes to present both, they must complete separate registrations and pay the applicable registration fee for each accepted paper.
- ❖ If any author like to go on publication then they have to submit paper within 30th October.
- ❖ All submitted abstracts will undergo plagiarism and AI-assisted content screening. The plagiarism and AI detection score must not exceed 30% individually. Abstracts exceeding this threshold may be rejected.
